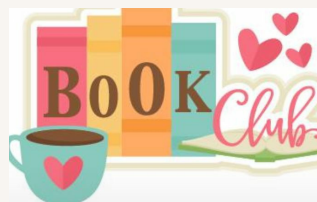

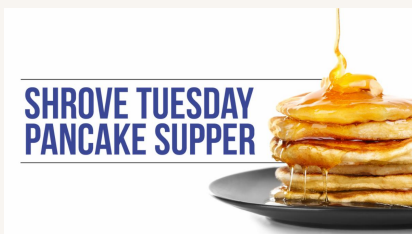
### LENTEN STEWARDSHIP PLEDGE

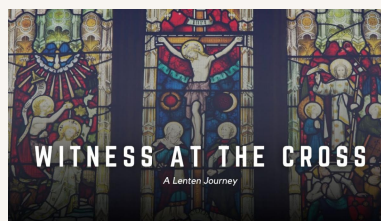

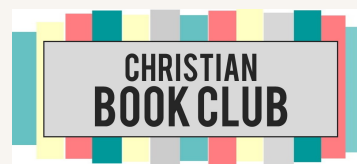
## ADULT FAITH NEWS


