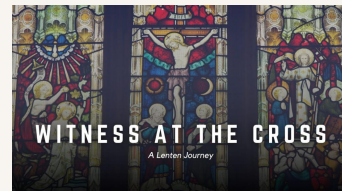


FROM THE PROPERTY COMMITTEE
